ECS MSIs provide classroom instruction that involves delivery of formal course curriculum in the areas of Basic First Aid, Cardio-Pulmonary Resuscitation (CPR), and Tactical Combat Casualty Care (TCCC), and when appropriate, provide certification of other personnel. ECS MSIs perform daily set-up and maintenance of all medical training aides utilized in ECS training.
